Steingruber/Hegi and Käslin/Brägger compete for Switzerland

Both Swiss teams competing at the Swiss Cup Zürich 2019 on Sunday November 3 are known: Giulia Steingruber and Oliver Hegi for Team Switzerland I and Pablo Brägger and Ilaria Käslin for Team Switzerland II will try to take back home the prestigious trophy.

Giulia Steingruber, Oliver Hegi, Ilaria Käslin and Pablo Brägger, those are the four Swiss Artistic gymnasts who will be competing next November 3 at the Hallenstadion Zürich to try and take the Swiss Cup Zürich trophy.

It will not be a premiere for Steingruber and Hegi since both of them have already taken part in this competition for pairs in the Hallenstadion. Yet, it will nevertheless be a premiere for the female gymnast from the Eastern part of the country and the male gymnast from the Canton of Aargau that they will compete together for Team Switzerland I.

The recent Swiss champion Giulia Steingruber will compete for the 7th time in this international competition by pairs. In 2017, for her last participation, she won the title together with Pablo Brägger. As for Oliver Hegi, also reigning Swiss champion and winner of the 2019 Swiss Gymnastics Festival in Aarau, it will be his 3rd participation after having ranked 3rd in 2017. This year, both of them will strive to climb up the highest step of the podium.

The slogan "All good things go by three" will drive Ilaria Käslin and Pablo Brägger through this year's competition as Team Switzerland II, not a premiere since both gymnasts already paired in 2015 and 2016 at the Swiss Cup Zürich but both times the duo Käslin/Brägger failed extremely short from the podium by ranking 4th. For their third attempt, will the reigning female champion of the Swiss Gymnastics Festival in Aarau and the 2017 European Champion at High Bar manage to get together onto the podium?

Host nations of the Swiss Cup Zürich 2019 will be announced at the beginning of October.
